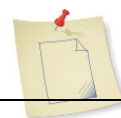




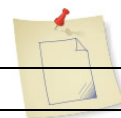

### 1. Script

Woman: Excuse me; do you know how I can get to the bank?  
 Officer: Sure! Which bank are you heading to?

### 2. Suggested activities

You can have a vocabulary game to introduce new words, prior to watching the video.

You can also have students make predictions based on the first screenshot and the vocabulary you introduced beforehand.

To reduce anxiety, let your pupils know that they will have a number of chances to get the information. 3 repetitions should be enough; the first one should be used for general understanding (just listening), during the second one students can complete the script (fill in), and the last one could be a good chance to check answers.

For the second activity, tell your students that the red circle represents the place where the two people are talking, and the squares represent the different key places the officer mentions.
