this tense is used to express the idea that an action started and finished at a specific time in the past.

Regular verbs need D, ED, or IED to form their past forms.\*

did  
did not  
(didn't)

### Examples

Affirmative

You saw her yesterday.

Negative

She didn't come to class on Friday.

Did you watch the news last night?
